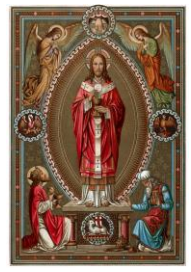

Eucharistic Adoration Mission

9-12 September 2017

Church of Our Lady

In preparation for the Parish Mission, let us pray and ponder on some well-known Eucharistic hymns which stemmed from prayerful hearts. This week we propose a very familiar one, *Pange Lingua/Tantum Ergo*, this too was the work of St Thomas Aquinas. It was composed to celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi. A literal English translation is offered which may help to appreciate the depth of the Latin text.
