If you live in the parish of St Johns Wood *and* are marrying outside of the parish *and* your papers are being prepared outside of this parish you will also need a letter of permission to marry outside of this, your parish of residence. If this is the case, please tick the box below and the necessary Letter of Permission will also be prepared for you.
